SPRING PLANT SAFETY

When looking at new houseplants, garden additions or even Mother's Day bouquets, keep your pets' safety in mind. Some popular plants that can pose dangers include, lilies (including Asiatic lilies and daylilies), azaleas, rhododendrons, sago palms, tulips, hydrangeas, peace lilies, Devil's Ivy or pothos, Lantana, daffodils, and hostas.

Opt for these instead: roses, gerber daisies, sunflowers, and orchids.

EXPANDING OUR SERVICES

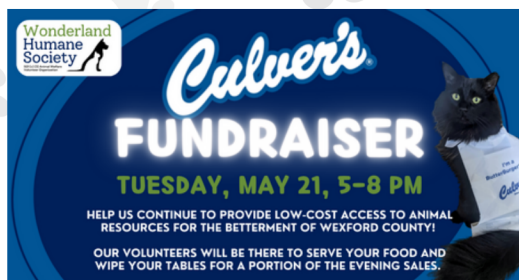
New Dog Voucher Program is accepting applications for reduced cost spay & neuter services.

To better serve the needs of our community, WHS is shifting to a voucher program that will work with several veterinary offices in the area. This program is designed to help Wexford County pet owners who could not otherwise afford this essential surgery. The money for this service is funded solely from donations and fundraisers held by WHS during the year. The tremendous call for help with this program far outnumbers the funds. Therefore, only a limited few can be considered as funds are raised.
